A major portion of a student's first- and second-year studies is a common curriculum of courses called the General Studies Program. The General Studies Program is designed to provide a fundamental basis for lifelong learning and advanced studies. General studies courses may not be used in meeting requirements for both the General Studies Program and the requirements for a major or minor.

Four hours of advanced biology (course with lab) may satisfy the following biology requirement, so long as the course does not and the student has satisfied the course prerequisites.
